How would you decorate a home so that it's beautiful, but still fun and practical enough for a modern family to live in? Take tips from K&H Design's modestly titled Exquisite Family Home in Fulham, west London. It was one of 20 worthy winners at this year's Sunday Times British Homes Awards, scooping the best interior design (over £500,000) category.

K&H designed it for a British family who wanted a revamp of their "forever home", which they had already lived in for 18 years. With three

teenagers to please, it was no easy task.

Combining classical features with contemporary art, the house has a bespoke shoe cupboard inspired by American folk art and a neon swimming lady rescued from God's Own Junkyard in Walthamstow, east London. The studio also added a games room big enough to fit 25 people in the basement, with banquette seating to flop onto on a rainy afternoon.
